Living the dream, that's what the new Volkswagen Crafter / Coachcraft based 'Coachburg 770' motorhome is all about. Built on a Crafter 50 cab chassis powered by a 100kW turbo diesel motor that delivers 300Nm of torque through the six speed Shiftmatic gearbox, the motorhome is a pleasure to drive.

Not only that, when all the features of the Coachburg are appreciated, a whole new world of motorhoming delight opens up. Imagine starting every day with all the comforts of home around you but unlike any hotel room in the location of your choosing.

Built using a Hi-tech vacuum moulded composite panel construction, the Coachburg body has the best of all worlds – strength, light weight and good insulation and is beautifully finished off in a Hi-Gloss finish. Large hopper style double glazed windows offer an every changing view, yet one protected from the weather if needed.



To enhance the outside lifestyle are features like the 4m roll out awning, stainless steel BBQ, outside work bench, hot and cold shower and a rear storage bin. Inside the Coachburg is a layout that has been neatly divided into three different living spaces. Up front is the lounge/dining area, with the kitchen being in the middle and the bedroom with full ensuite at the rear.

All the cabinetry work in the Coachburg is built using water resistant light ply and finished off with a high pressure laminate for both an attractive look and a long service life. Fabric lined walls and a glossy ceiling add to an attractive interior look. For comfort and privacy, the windows have integrated roller insect screens and privacy blinds, as well as curtains.

Very effective use has been made of the Volkswagen Crafter driver's cab. Both driver and passenger seats are upholstered in leather and fabric and fully swivel around. This in conjunction with the sideways facing lounges and centrally fitted table creates a multi functional lounge/dining area.

Every good motorhome should have a kitchen to satisfy a travelling cordon bleu chef and the Coachburg catering facilities aim to please. Naturally there is a stove, grill and oven alongside a stainless steel sink. Those other essential items, a large two door fridge freezer unit and a microwave oven are also built in.



The rear bedroom offers a number of features - permanent rear double bed, large wardrobe, overhead roof locker storage and the adjacent ensuite. That too has every feature you might expect in a luxury motorhome. Complete with separate shower cubicle, vanity wash basin, swivel toilet with china bowl and shaving cabinet, it leaves nothing wanting.

If needed there is second double bed fitted into the Luton peak above the Crafter driver's cab. It is suitable for adults, the children or the grandchildren or simply for extra storage.

Not only is the Volkswagen Crafter the latest piece of automotive technology but the Coachburg is too. Fully fitted out with a 230V/12V power system, it has two 110 amp hour deep cycle batteries, a 15 amp charger and a 125 watt solar panel. Energy efficient fluorescent and halogen lighting is used throughout. Entertainment is provided by a full sound system and a 48cm TV/DVD unit. An automatic satellite system and digital receiver gives TV reception wherever the location.



Offering all the great features of both worlds, Volkswagen has joined in partnership with Coachcraft to create the luxurious Coachburg 770 motorhome. An experience that should be appreciated soon!
